History of RIPE

- Started in May 1989
- Operational coordination of IP Networks
- 5-day RIPE Meetings held twice a year
- Working Groups, Task Forces and BoF sessions

- Work is done in **RIPE Working Groups**
- RIPE Policy Development Process (PDP):
open, transparent, bottom-up, documented



Regional Focus (1)

- First ENOG/RIPE NCC Regional Meeting outside Russia
- ENOG region one of the fastest growing in the RIPE NCC Service Region



Regional Focus (2)

- ENOG 2, Moscow, Nov. 2011: 20 Ukrainians
