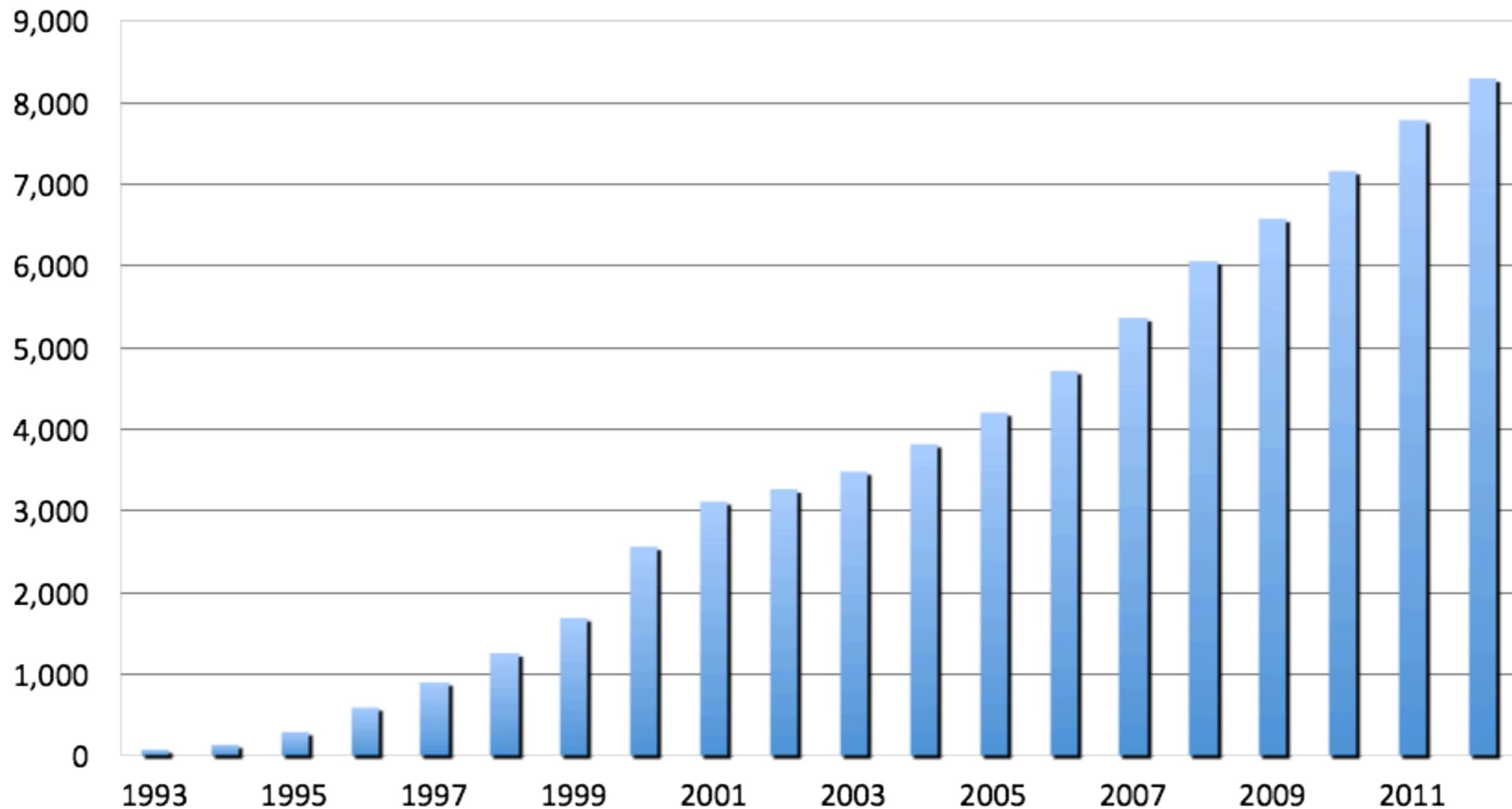

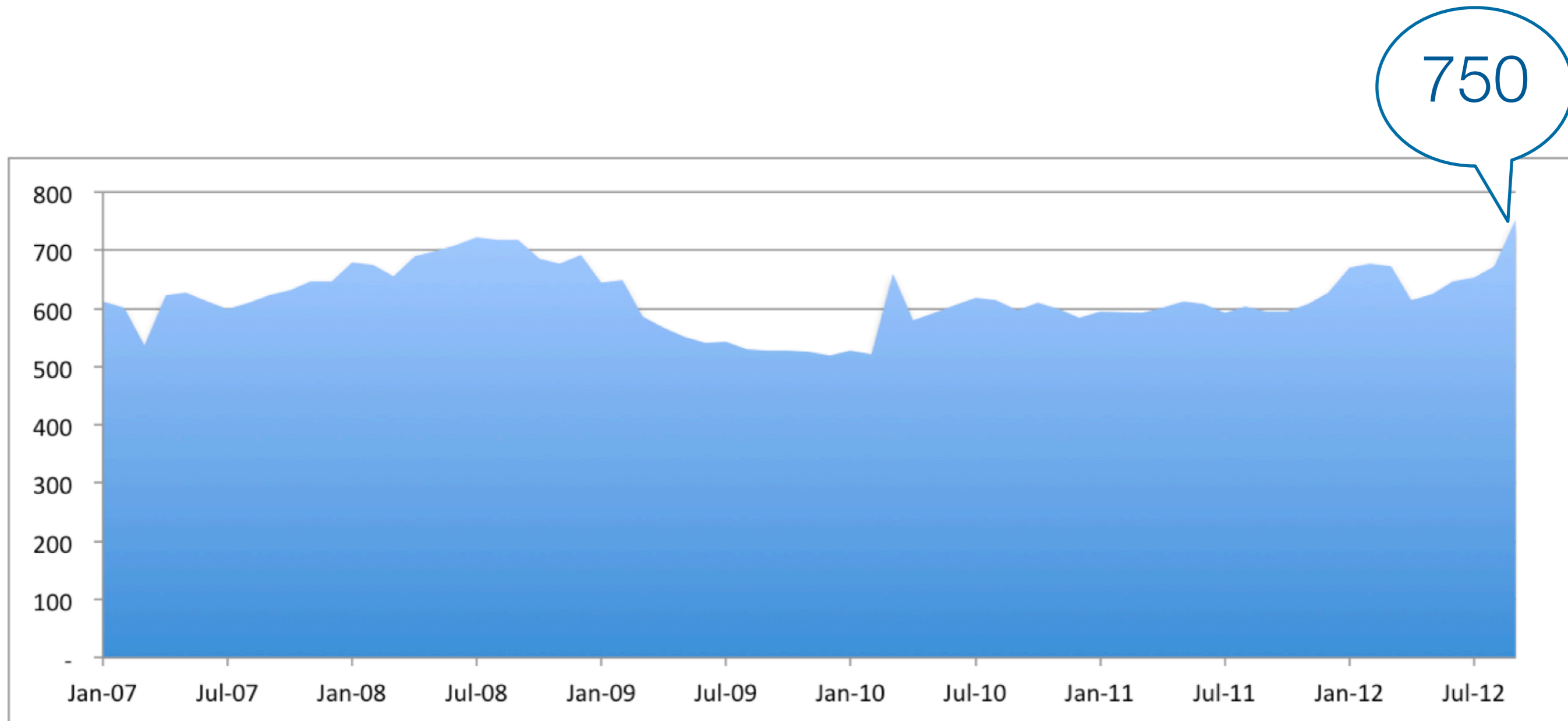

# RIPE NCC members with Multiple LIRs

---

- After carrying out regular due diligence audit, we found that some legal entities are responsible for multiple LIRs
- This means these entities have multiple memberships and thus multiple voting rights
- Under Dutch Civil Law a legal entity can only have *one voting right in an association*
- *Affected members have been contacted*
- *Policy implications on use of last /8*



# Dutch Police Order Update

---

- On 8 November 2011, Dutch police presented an order to "lock" registrations in the RIPE DB
- RIPE NCC is seeking clarification on the legal basis
  - Hearing 29 November
  - Decision in 2013
- Two affected blocks of IPv4 address space were de-registered after non-payment
- These blocks were then re-allocated in August, according to procedures

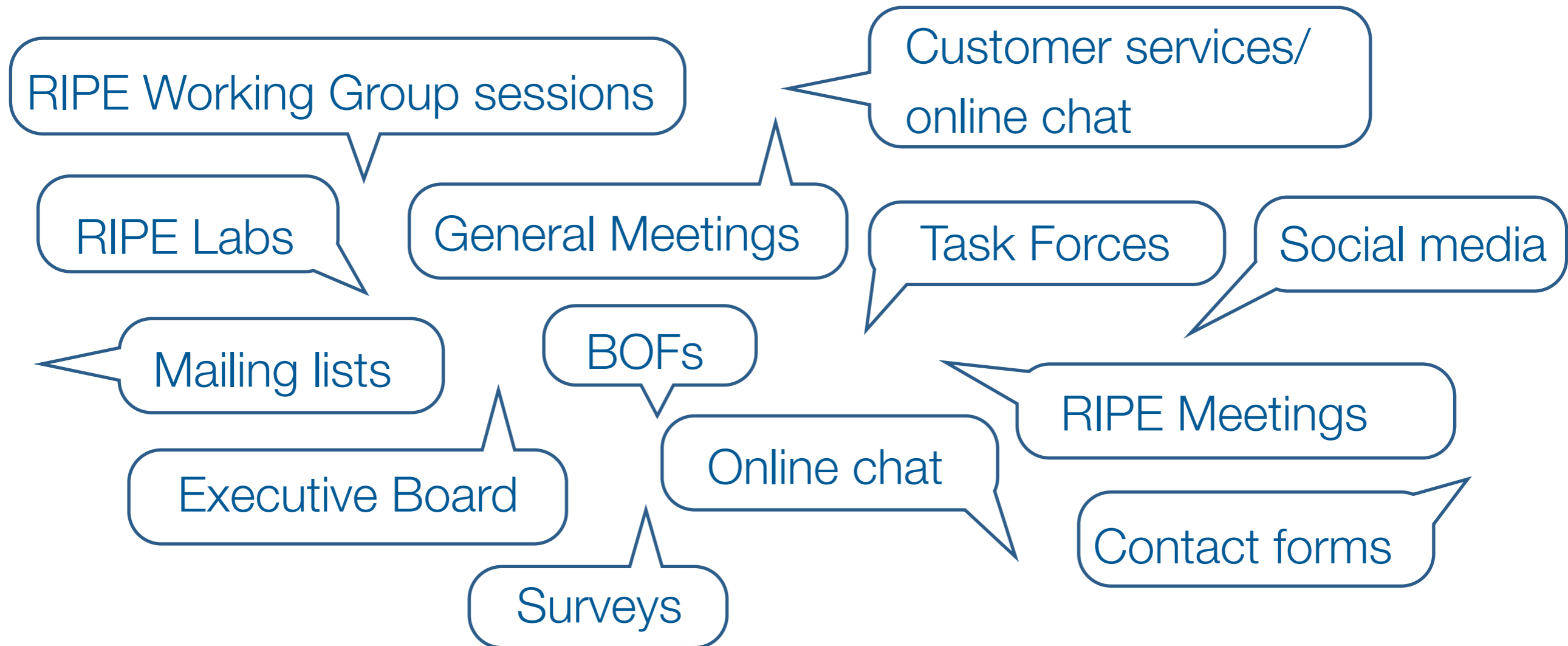

# Customer Contact

---

- 3-Question post-contact survey since January
  - 93 responses, 83% of customers satisfied



- Live Chat from 13:00 to 17:00 CET
  - doubled availability
  - very happy customers (5 out of 5 stars)
  - 314 sessions since August 2011
- Live chat for Registration Services in Q1 2013

# Membership and Stakeholder Survey (1)

---

- Membership and Stakeholder Surveys give **valuable** feedback: 825 respondents in 2011
- Enables us to gauge membership and key stakeholders' opinions to help formulate long-term organisation strategy
- 2011 survey identified more than 50 key areas that we could improve on
- Over the last 12 months we have been actively working to improve these key areas and will publicly document these developments shortly

# Membership and Stakeholder Survey (2)

---

- Now planning to conduct surveys approximately every two years
  - In loose coordination with APNIC
- Dynamic nature of the industry and speed of developments
  - Membership community and other stakeholder groups change regularly
- Preparing for our next survey
  - to be launched at the RIPE 66 Meeting, Dublin, May 2013

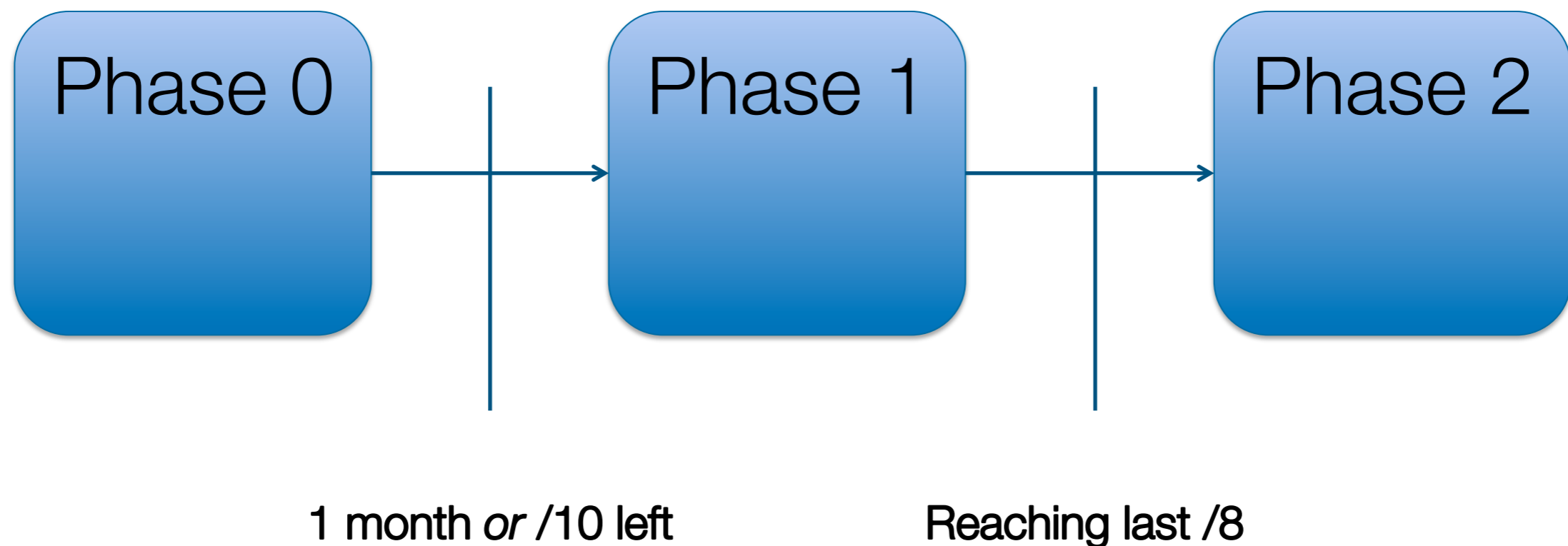

---



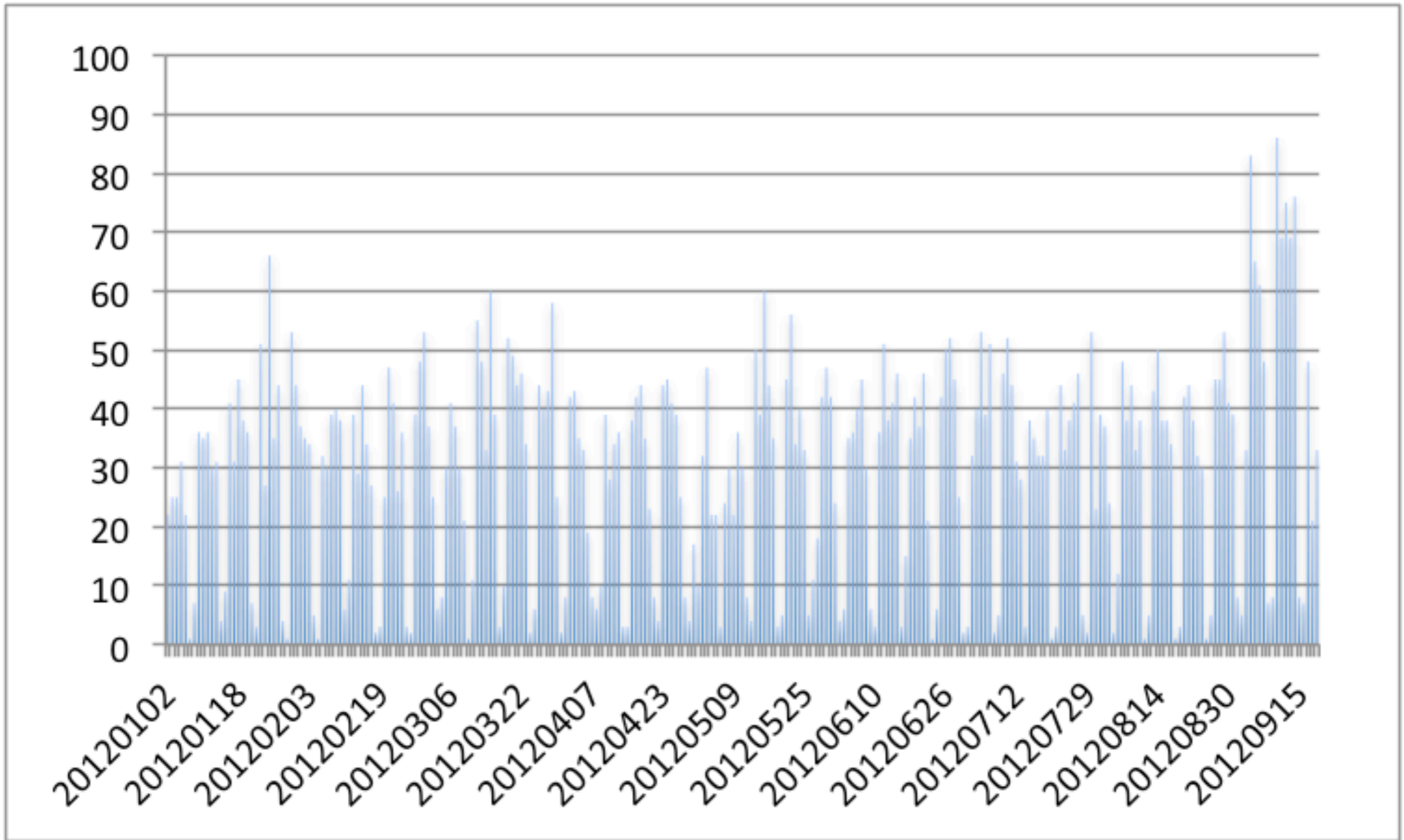


# IPv4 run out - Phase 2

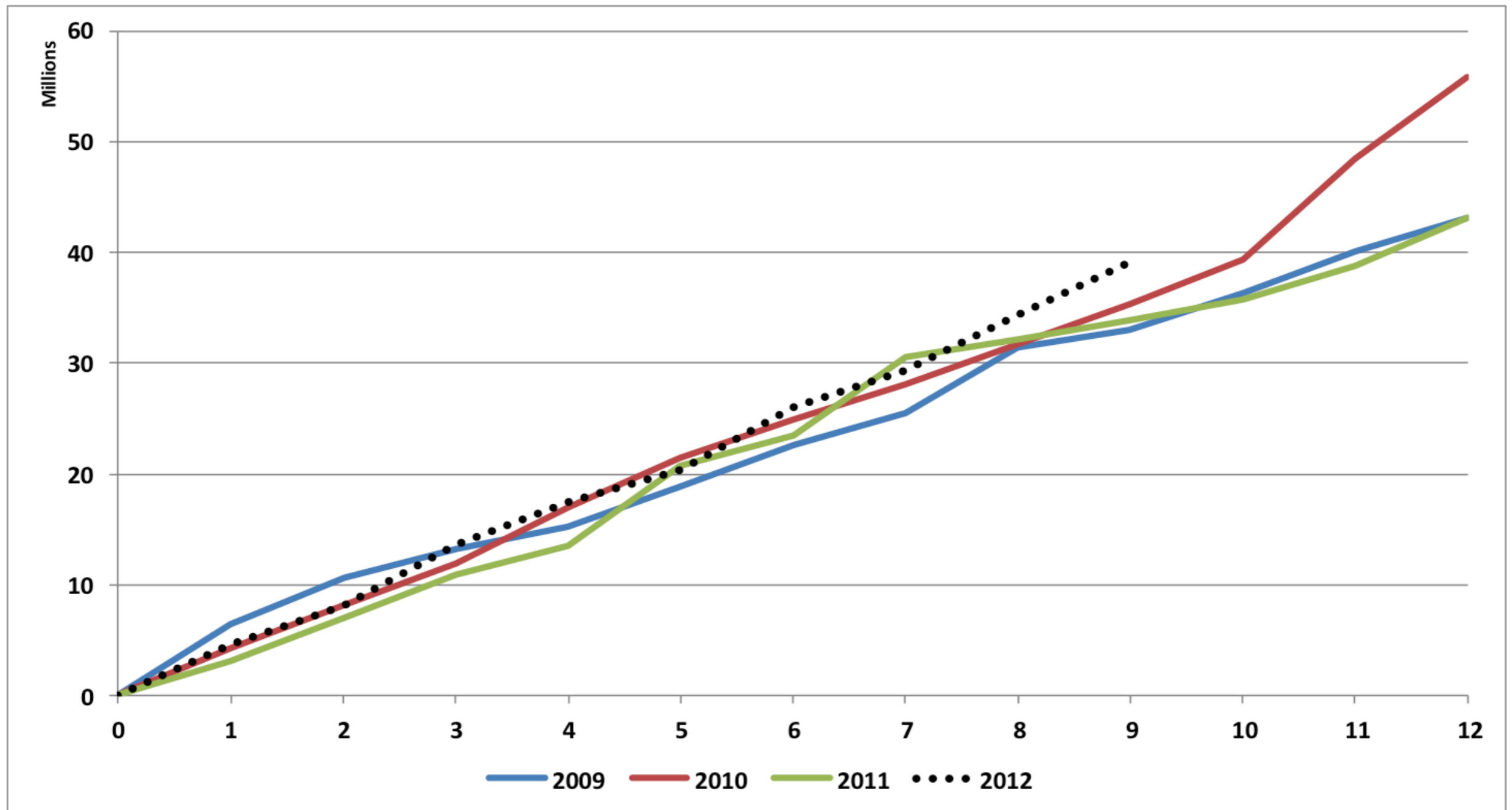
---

- Started on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2012
- When the RIPE NCC reached the last /8
- Members can receive **one** /22 (1,024 IPv4 addresses), even if they can justify a larger allocation
  - LIRs must already have an IPv6 allocation from an upstream LIR or the RIPE NCC
- No new IPv4 Provider Independent (PI) address space is being assigned

# New IPv4 Requests



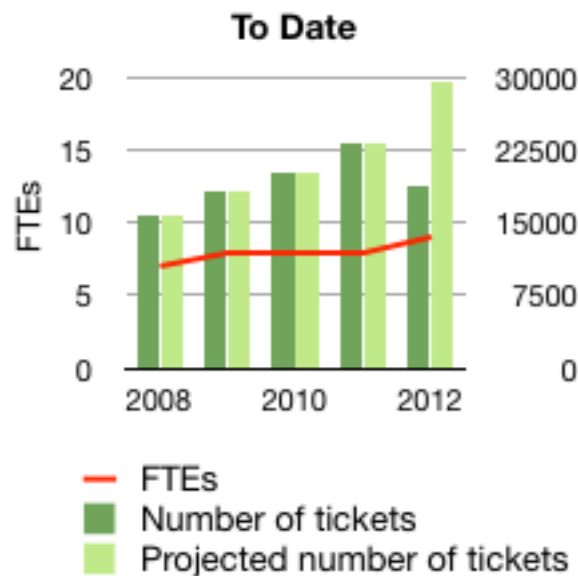
# Cumulative IPv4 Address Space



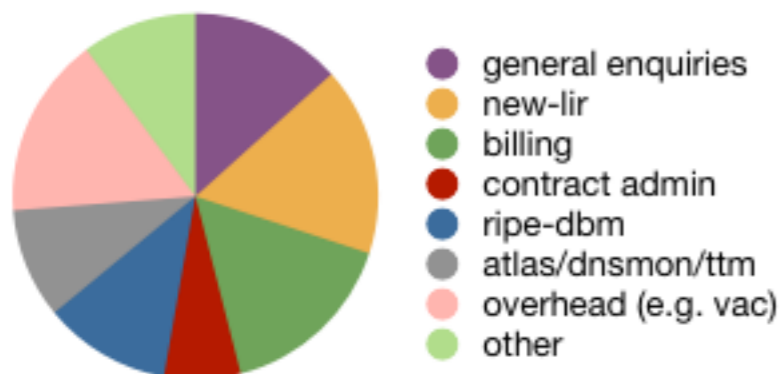

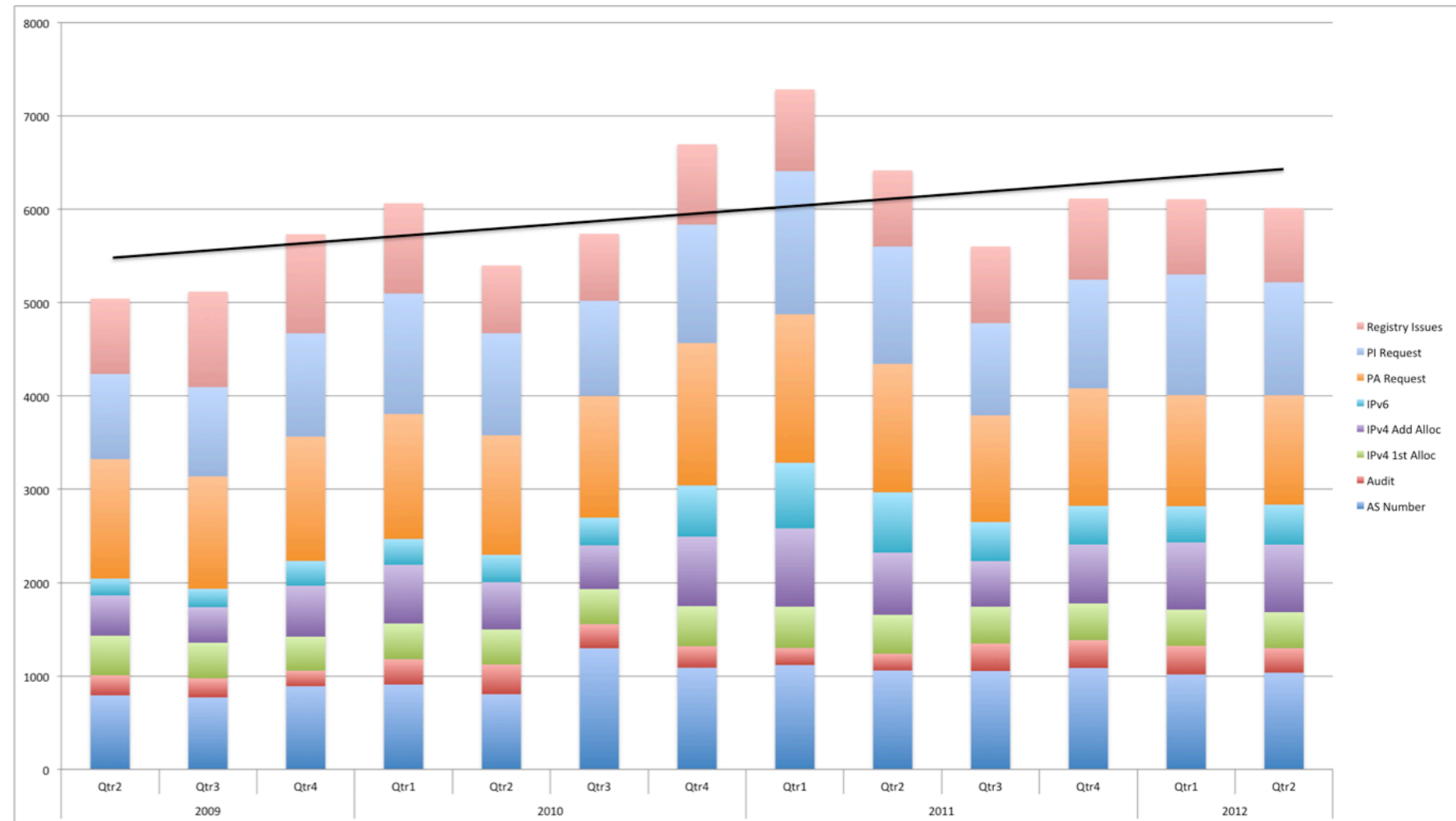
## CS tickets

# Creating Value For Members

---

- RIPE Database
  - Focus on developing new whois backend software
    - Opens up options for new functionality later
  - RESTful API is very popular: >500,000 queries per day
- RIPE NCC RPKI Service and Validation Toolset
  - BGP Origin Validation: more reliable routing decisions
  - 1,147 members certified their resources
  - Route Origin Authorisations cover around five /8 blocks

# New Service: IP Analyser

---

- IPv4 feature set:
  - Shows all your allocations and assignments
  - Shows free space, makes suggestions for assignments
  - Notifications of invalid assignments and steps to solve
- Data presented as:
  - User friendly web page in the LIR Portal
  - JSON and Plain Text (asused style report)
