
2010 ATLAS Initiative: DDoS Trends 2009 - 2010

Attacks over 10Gb/sec on the rise!

- Proportion of monitored attacks over 10Gb/sec has grown by 470% from 2009
- Monitoring > 10Gb/sec attack approx every 6.5 hours
 - World 2009 Size Break-Out, BPS

 ->1<2Gbps
 ->2<5Gbps
 ->5<10Gbps
 ->10<20Gbps
 ->20Gbps

- Increase in large bps / pps attacks year on year:
 - 319% increase in number of monitored attacks > 10Gbps from 2009 – 2010.
 - 45% growth in number of attacks > 10Mpps.




MAT WG Sessions - Examples

- Server reports "weather conditions" of each ISP




MAT WG Sessions - Examples
