## **Policy Development?**





- Policies are the rules under which the RIPE NCC works!
- Registration and use of IPv4, IPv6 are based on these rules
- Everyone in our region must follow these rules
- ... but policies can be changed



### **RIPE Policy Development**

- RIPE policies are made by people like you!
- Policy development in RIPE is done via working groups — following an open, bottom-up, consensus-based approach
- People share policy ideas in working group sessions at RIPE Meetings...
- ...but all discussions and decisions take place on the mailing lists



### **Policy Development Process (PDP)**





# 2015-01, "Alignment of Transfer Requirements for IPv4 Allocations"

- Before: IPv4 allocations made by the RIPE NCC can be transferred immediately
- Problem: LIRs could be opened, the /22 IPv4 allocation requested and immediately transferred
- Proposal: Apply the 24-month holding period to IPv4 allocations made by the RIPE NCC (the same as for transfers from other LIRs)



  - Inter-RIR transfers
  - Additional criteria for evaluating large IPv6 allocations


