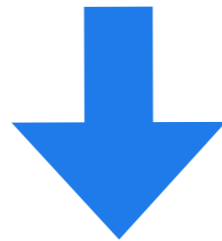

- **Policies are the rules under which the RIPE NCC works!**
- Registration and use of IPv4, IPv6 are based on these rules
- Everyone in our region must follow these rules
- ...but policies can be changed

- **RIPE policies are made by people like you!**
- Policy development in RIPE is done via working groups — following an open, bottom-up, consensus-based approach
- People share policy ideas in working group sessions at RIPE Meetings...
- ...but all discussions and decisions take place on the mailing lists

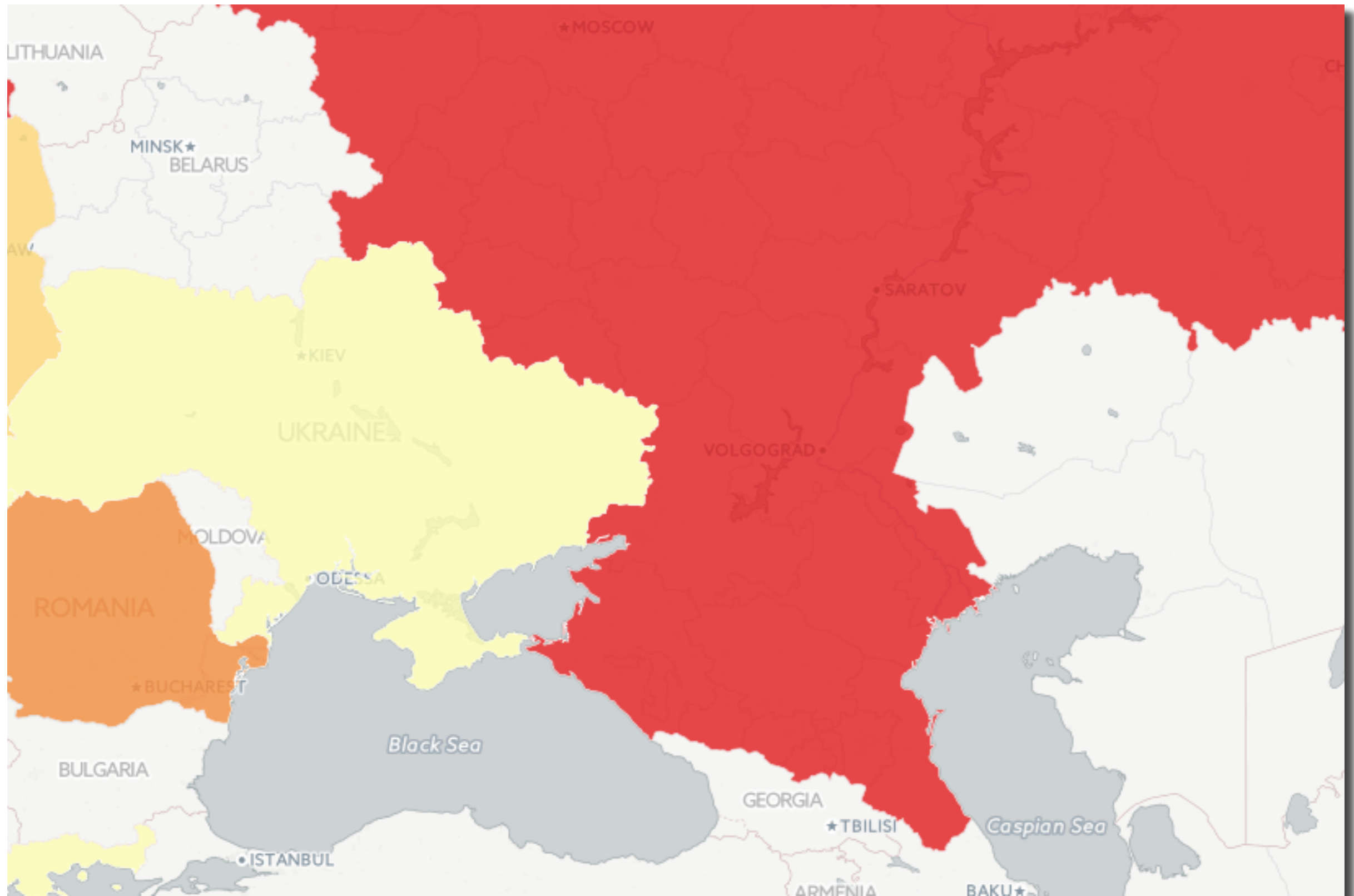

## 2015-01, “Alignment of Transfer Requirements for IPv4 Allocations”

- Before: IPv4 allocations made by the RIPE NCC can be transferred immediately
- Problem: LIRs could be opened, the /22 IPv4 allocation requested and immediately transferred
- Proposal: Apply the 24-month holding period to IPv4 allocations made by the RIPE NCC (the same as for transfers from other LIRs)

	
<p>These transfers go against the spirit of that policy.</p> <p>Transfers have a serious impact on last /8</p> <p>The last /8 block should be kept for new organisations to receive some IPv4 space</p>	<p>Blocks cheap access to IPv4</p> <p>Transfers have a no serious impact on last /8</p> <p>Doesn't really help, as transfers via "mergers and acquisitions" are still possible</p>





- **Ongoing:**

- 2014-03, “Remove Multihoming Requirement for AS Number Assignments”
- 2015-04, “RIPE Resource Transfer Policies”

- **Recently Accepted:**

- 24-month holding period for all IPv4 allocations
- Inter-RIR transfers
- Additional criteria for evaluating large IPv6 allocations
