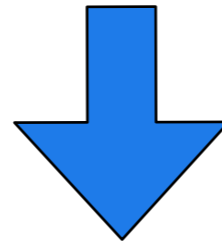

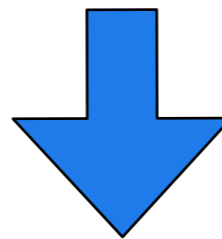


- The **RIPE community** develops and sets policies for the technical coordination of the Internet and the distribution of Internet number resources in the RIPE NCC's service region.
- “**RIPE community**” is the collective term for individuals and organisations, members or not, that have an interest in the way the Internet is managed, structured or governed.

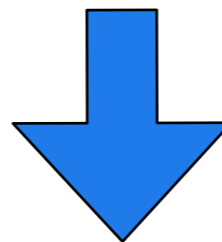
