- Central Asia has (very) high connectivity costs
- General lack of interconnectivity between local network operators
- Lower bandwidth + higher latency
- Low user penetration

- To understand what existing IXP initiatives (if any) exist
- Regulatory situation not well understood and sometimes unclear
- Which Content & Cloud Providers are interested in the region?
- What capacity building is required?
- Where investment can be best directed?
