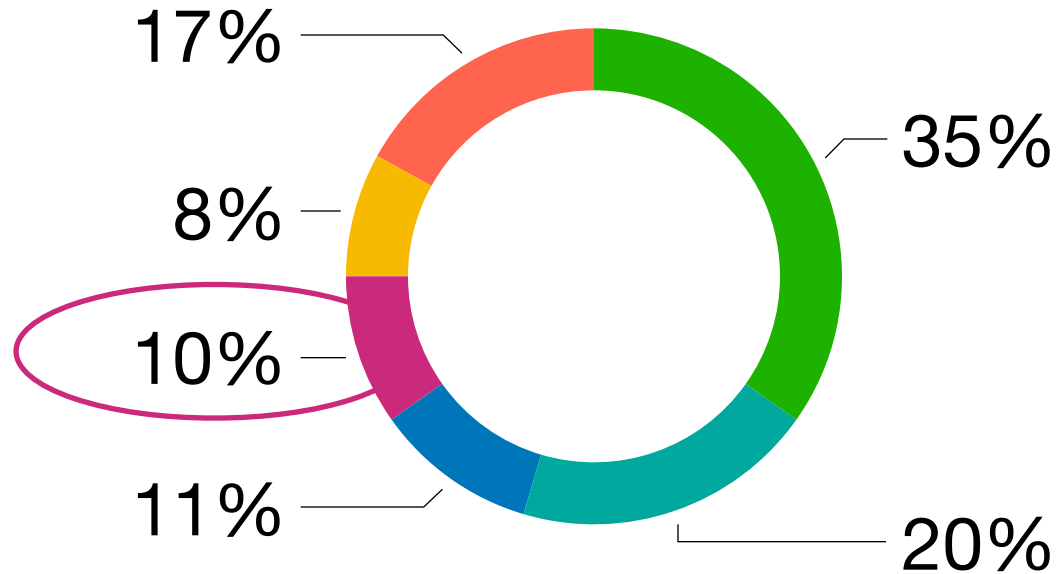

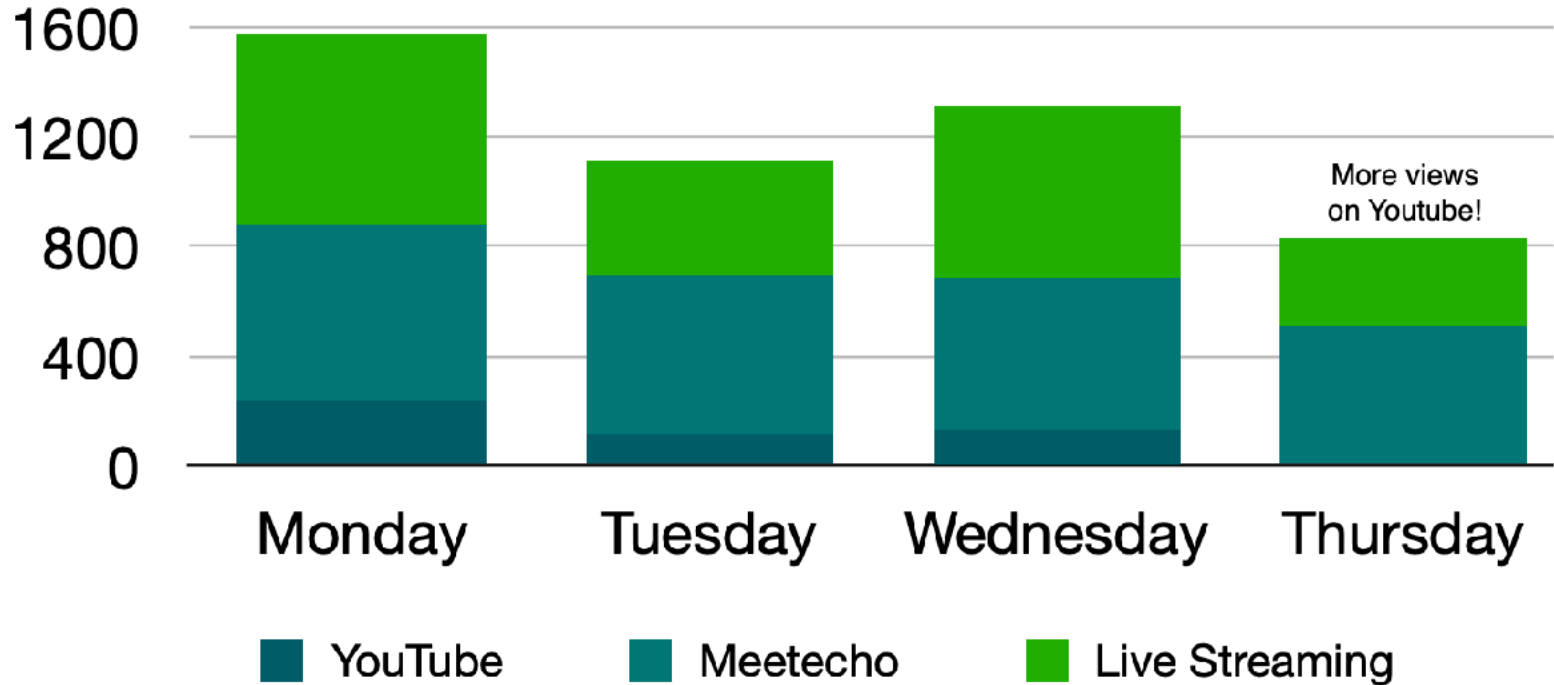

Updating the RIPE Code of Conduct

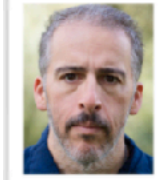
- Task Force formed after RIPE 80

- Scope defined as “all participation in RIPE”

 - Reporting details

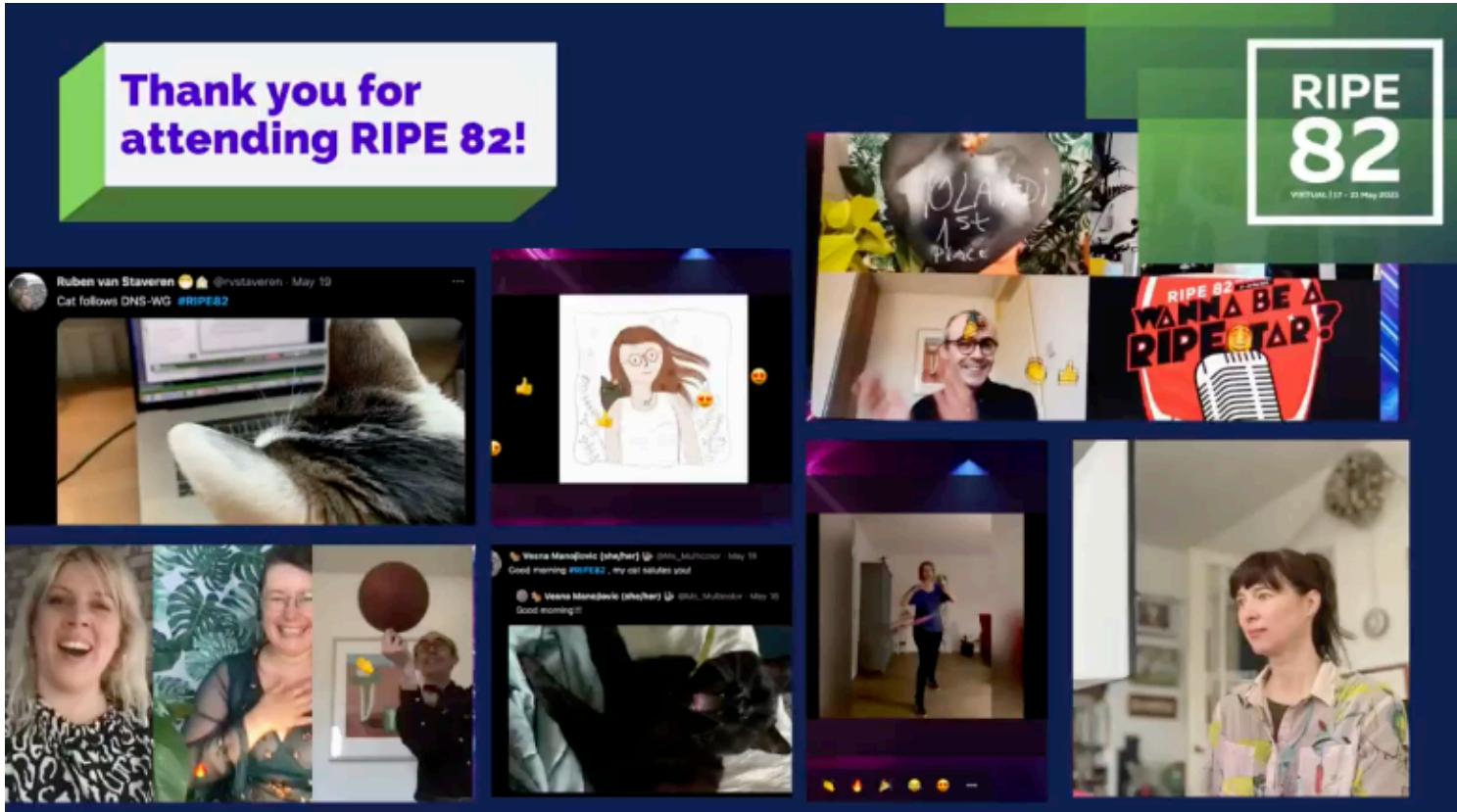
RIPE DB Requirements TF - Recommendations

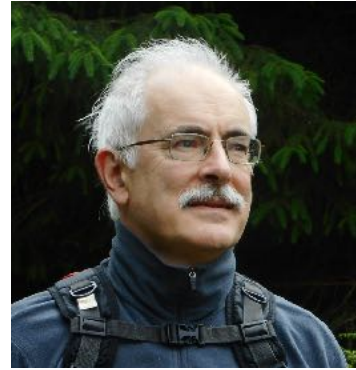
